

REQUIREMENTS FOR FILLING IN AN IN-GROUND POOL

1. Apply online at the City of Apple Valley website, Departments and Services, Building Inspections, Permits, **Building – Plan Review Required “Residential” – Demolition - Residential.**
2. To obtain a survey, complete a data request. The data request can be obtained at the City of Apple Valley website, in the search – type “data request”. Fill out the data request, requesting a survey for the exact property address and return the data request by email to inspect@cityofapplevalley.org. When the data request is received by the City of Apple Valley, a survey will be forwarded to you. Draw the pool and accessory building locations that will be demolished with this permit on the survey and upload this survey with your plans to Projectdox.
3. An electrical permit is required for termination of the power supply. The permit application is online at the City of Apple Valley website, Departments and Services, Building Inspections, Permits, **Alter/Remodel – Residential – One Trip Project.**
4. A mechanical permit is required for disconnection of a gas line. The permit application is online at City of Apple Valley website, Departments and Services, Building Inspections, Permits, **HVAC/Mechanical – Residential - Gas Line Only.**
5. All metal walls, vinyl liners and any pool equipment shall be removed and properly disposed of.
6. All concrete shall be removed and disposed of offsite. No construction debris shall be buried on the property.
7. Only clean fill may be deposited on the site and properly compacted to control settlement.
8. Vegetation must be established on the site when work is complete, per City of Apple Valley ordinance.
9. A pool demolition may require a separate NRMP (Natural Resources Permit). Contact Natural Resources at 952-953-2464 for more information. The permit application is online at the City of Apple Valley website, Departments and Services, Building Inspections, Permits, **NRMP (Plan Review Required).**
