The City is pleased to once again offer residents an annual bare root tree and shrub sale to help diversify properties. We encourage replanting a diversity of species due to Emerald Ash Borer and other future pests or diseases. Residents can purchase up to **3 trees** and **6 shrubs** per property at wholesale prices.



Trees	Approx size at pickup	Features	Cost
Swamp White Oak	6-8'	Drought tolerant, resistant to oak wilt, produces acorns, leaves persistent into winter. Must prune in winter. Mature height 50-60'.	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Red Oak	6-8'	Fast-growing native oak; rounded symmetrical habit when older. Glossy, dark green leaves have pointed lobes, turn bright red in fall. Must prune in winter. Mature height 60-80'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
River Birch (single stem)	6-8'	Prefers moist soils, cinnamon-brown exfoliating bark, and great yellow fall color. Mature height 40-50'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Autumn Gold Ginkgo	6-8'	Pyramidal, upright shape, spreads at maturity. Seedless male variety with no fruit. Green foliage, golden in the fall. Statement tree with unique fan shaped leaves. Pest free and tolerant of urban conditions. Mature height 40-60'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Hackberry	6-8'	Fast-growing native tree with unique gray, corky bark. Tolerant of harsh urban conditions. Mature height 50-70'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Honeycrisp Apple	5-6'	Offered again by popular demand! Sweet, exceptionally crisp and juicy apple tree, patented by the U of MN. Grow your own State fruit!	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Japanese Tree Lilac	5-6'	Disease and pest-resistant. Showy, fragrant, creamy-white flower clusters bloom in mid-June followed by a brown fruit capsule. Mature height 20-25'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
White Pine (Potted)	24"	Fast growing, soft-needled evergreen with long blue-green foliage. Needs moist, well-drained soil. Intolerant of salts and air pollution. Protect from deer and water at base of tree, not over the tree. Mature height 50-80'.	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Shrubs			
American Hazelnut	2-3'	Large native shrub useful for border or natural plantings. Round ½" nuts are edible. Yellow/orange fall color. Round shape. Mature height 6-8'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Glossy Black Chokeberry	2-3'	Ornamental shrub with glossy green foliage that turns a brilliant red in fall. White flowers in May followed by persistent black fruit – birds love it. Mature height 4-6'.	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Yellow Twig Dogwood	2-3'	An improved selection of the native yellow twig dogwood selected for its disease resistance. Bright yellow stems provide striking color all winter long. Mature height 6-8'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Sumac Cutleaf Staghorn	2-3'	Hairy, crimson-colored fruit spikes appear in August and persist into winter. Performs well on poor sites. Mature height 12-15'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
Meadowlark Forsythia	2-3'	Large shrub with semi-arching branches and dark green foliage. Showy yellow flowers bloom in early spring. Mature height 8-10'	<b>SOLD OUT</b>
